The Department of Sociology at East Carolina University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in the area of medical sociology to begin August 2023, contingent on funding. Candidates must be able to teach and mentor students in quantitative research methods and be committed to quality teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate level. Effective teaching and mentoring will involve inclusive, engaging, and respectful pedagogy and practices. ECU values a diverse and inclusive environment and strongly encourages applications from women, people of color, and historically underrepresented groups. The Department of Sociology in particular is dedicated to diversity and inclusion. We are committed to increasing representation of and support for individuals from groups traditionally under-represented in academia and to creating an environment that encourages the open exchange of ideas, learning and dialogue across cultural and group boundaries.
