We seek candidates whose research focuses on (1) **Family and Gender** or (2) **Inequalities and Statistics/Quantitative Methods**. For both positions, we would particularly welcome applicants whose work includes social network approaches, broadly defined. Quantitative scholars with other expertise, qualitative scholars, and mixed-methods scholars are also invited to apply. *Scholars eligible for both positions are encouraged to apply to both positions.*

Successful candidates will be expected to maintain an active program of research, teach, contribute to departmental service, and mentor graduate students in our Ph.D. program. Applicants must have a PhD degree in sociology or a closely related field by the start date of employment.
